

REVISED STANDARD ORDER OF VISITATION
OF THE
COURT OF COMMON PLEAS, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, OHIO

The standard Court order for visitation is "reasonable visitation." If the parties cannot agree between themselves as to what is reasonable visitation or unless the Court orders otherwise, the following is the standard order of visitation for the non-custodial parent.

1. The non custodial parent shall have visitation on alternate weekends from Friday at 6:00 p.m. to Sunday at 6:00 p.m. beginning on the first Friday following the filing date of the judgment entry; except as set for in #2 below.
2. For holiday visitation, the first year the non-custodial parent shall have visitation from 6:00 p.m. Wednesday before Thanksgiving to 6:00 p.m. Thursday Thanksgiving Day. The following year the custodial parent will have that visitation, and thereafter the parties shall alternate Thanksgiving visitation.

For the first year Christmas visitation, the non-custodial parent shall have visitation on December 24th from noon to 8:00 p.m.; the following year the non-custodial parent shall have visitation Christmas Day from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.; and this pattern will alternate annually thereafter.
3. The Court allows a fifteen minute leeway period of time on either side of the pickup and return times of visitation for the parties to appear.
4. There shall be summer visitation each year for the non-custodial parent for three weeks; said non-custodial parent shall notify custodial parent forty-five days in advance of the three week period.
